Announcement of Availability of Prevention Program development funds for 1997/1998

The County of Carroll, under agreement with the NH Division for Children, Youth and Families, is seeking proposals from interested persons for programs designed to prevent child involvement and/or out-of-home placement for children up to the age of eighteen. Start-up funding is available for up to seventy-five (75%) of program budget; on-going programs receive up to fifty percent (50%) of their program cost. Availability of funds to Carroll County is contingent upon state appropriations.

"Placement" includes children in foster home care, group homes, residential treatment facilities, and the Youth Development Center. Prevention programs are defined as those programs that can provide family support, or services or treatment, for at risk children and families. The programs must provide support for children remaining in their homes. A panel is particularly interested in after school and crisis respite programs.

The funds are made available through state legislation. The method of distribution has been established through rules adopted by the Commissioner of Health and Human Services in accordance with state law. Monitoring and evaluation of fund programs are the responsibility of the County.
