Dear Applicant:

The Department of Environmental Services (DES) Wetlands Bureau has determined that the filing fee submitted with the application is insufficient. The appropriate filing fee for this application is calculated as a \$100 base fee, plus \$0.10 per square foot of dredge or fill impacts (\$5720.00). The Wetlands Bureau has received \$570.00 of the total \$5820.00 due. Please submit a check for the remaining \$5250.00. DES staff will perform a detailed technical of this file upon receipt of the outstanding fee. Submittal of the correct fee is required by law prior to a detailed technical review and submission of the required fee in no way guarantees approval of the application.

Please be advised that DES does not typically approve applications for this type of work and from a cursory review of the application materials and plans submitted, it appears the project as proposed is not approvable. Although a complete review has not been done at this time due to insufficient fee, there appears to be significant information missing from the plans. If you wish to continue with the project there are some important issues that you will want to consider with any future submittals. DES is aware of the generally sandy nature of the entire Ossipee Lake area and the possibility of exotic milfoil present in the cove. The items that should be addressed by future submittals to facilitate a complete review if you wish to continue include: erosion controls during the dredging, dewatering basins, dredge spoils characterization and potential contaminated spoils handling, dredge depth and cross sections, the affects on the abutters due to changing the stream flow dynamics, methods for dealing with exotic milfoil if encountered and, all other information as required by Wt 302.04.

Please include the file number (2005-02516) on all correspondence and provide to the town Conservation Commission a copy of all information submitted to this office. Please submit the above-requested information as soon as practicable. In accordance with recent changes to RSA 482-A:3, if the requested information is not received within 120 days of this request, the department is obligated to deny the application. Therefore, if DES does not receive a complete response to the above-requested information by June 10, 2006, your permit will be denied.
