

Scott informed the selectmen that the new truck at MacDonald's is \$685 more than original quote. The difference will be posted to truck repairs. Donovan's will be doing the plow work to the new truck. The amount due to MacDonald's is \$34,870.00.

Scott will place a Bid Notice for a 2000 F450 four-wheel drive with plow and dump body with a minimum bid of \$10,000.00 and a 1972 Chevy fire engine. The notice will run in the Conway Sun on Wed, Thurs, and Fri noting a submittal deadline of October 31, 2005 at 7:00 pm and opening of October 31, 2005 at 7:30 pm.

Scott will look into the difference of leasing an excavator versus renting. Scott will get a price on a new sander too.


Jim brought up for discussion a complaint by Chuck Depew of how Marina Lot #42 is being used. The concern regards use of the Alvino Road. The ZBA ruling states Alvino Road is to be used for emergency use only; it was used during a bass tournament for traffic flow. Another issue was storage of boats on the lot. The selectmen decided no action to take regarding the use of Alvino Road because it was a safety issue and the board was notified ahead. The boat storage is for boats owned only by the marina that are for sale or rent can be there passed November 21<sup>st</sup>. Jim will respond to Chuck Depew. Donna will reiterate to the marina that Alvino Road use is for extenuating circumstances with prior notice made to the selectmen.




Donna will not be available for the November 7<sup>th</sup> meeting.
