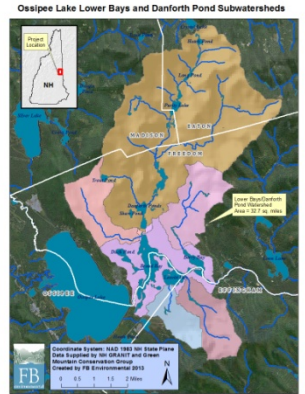


Invited July 24, 2013 – Residents and Landowners

These questions and more will be answered on July 24th at a public meeting to be held at the Freedom Town Hall from 6:00pm - 8:00pm. The local economy in the Ossipee Watershed relies on a healthy environment and clean water- it is our life-blood.

A Watershed Management Planning project is being initiated in the area around Danforth Pond and the lower bays of Ossipee Lake to ensure future generations can enjoy what we do today. The concept is to understand and project future nutrient loadings to the lake, set goals and prioritize needs and methods that will allow for future growth and development while protecting the water quality. The project includes a significant education and outreach component to engage residents and decision makers in watershed protection dialogue and activity. Funding is being provided by NH Department of Environmental Services but will not instigate further regulatory requirements from our State government. This is a project for and by local residents, municipalities and business entities.
